



SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION 2012

Cranbrook Summer Art Institute has a proud tradition of providing scholarships to deserving students. In 2011, around a third of our students had some form of scholarship to help pay for tuition. With the generosity of private and public donors we are hoping to provide funding to give more students the chance to study on the campus of one of the nation's most beautiful and respected graduate art schools, the Cranbrook Academy of Art.

CSAI offers three-week intensive art classes taught by Academy artists and alumni. Each class runs from 9:30 until 3:30 Monday through Friday. Full tuition for a class is \$995, which includes all material costs, a field trip, and equipment usage. Lunch and transportation to and from campus are not included.

WHAT IS OFFERED AND HOW IT IS DONE

Full Scholarships: Full scholarships cover tuition and material costs. This award is given to students who have demonstrated talent and clear financial need.

Partial Scholarships: Several scholarships valued between \$200 to \$500 are available. Partial scholarships may be awarded at any time before the schedules start of a course. Partial scholarships are based first on need and then on ability.

Qualifications: Must be between the ages of 13 and 18 by June 25. Criteria of both need and ability will be weighed in the decision. Keep this in mind when completing the application procedure. While CSAI does not require financial records, we do need to know about the applicant's financial need as well as his or her demonstrated ability in art. Scholarships are intended to help talented students with financial need attend CSAI.

Judging: Cranbrook Academy of Art staff make decisions about the dispersion of scholarship money.

Deadline: Applications should be postmarked by Friday, April 20. HOWEVER, applications received after this deadline may still earn a partial scholarship.

Be sure to read this portion carefully. Failure to follow these procedures may affect the judging.

Images of work

Include no more than three representations of your work. They may be submitted in any form, including cd, computer print, Xerox copy, or photograph. Do not send original artwork! Material may be returned if you include a self-addressed stamped envelope large enough to hold the material.

Student written portion: In a single page, please describe your interest in taking a class at CSAI. You may want to include any awards you have won or your plans for the future. This is your time to explain why you are a good candidate for a scholarship that is based both on need and ability.

Teacher portion: Please describe this student's ability and interest in art (either in a specific discipline or art in general). In your opinion, describe how well qualified this student is, keeping in mind that this competitive scholarship offer is based both on need and ability.

Optional parent/guardian portion: You have the option to address the financial need of the student without the student needing to disclose the information.

Rank your top three preferences, writing "1", "2" and "3" next to your choices. Select only three classes total, NOT three in each session.
