



FINANCIAL AID APPLICATION 2010

Cranbrook Summer Art Institute has a proud tradition of providing scholarships and financial aid to deserving students. In 2009, around 33% of our students had some form of financial assistance to help pay for tuition. With the generosity of private and public donors we are hoping to provide even more funding which should give more students the chance to study on the campus of one of the nation's most beautiful and respected graduate art schools, the Cranbrook Academy of Art.

CSAI offers three-week intensive art classes taught by Academy artists and alumni. Each class runs from 9:30 until 3:30 Monday through Friday. Full tuition for a class is \$995, which includes all materials costs, field trips, and equipment usage. Lunch is not included in tuition. Boarding is optional and costs an additional \$2505. Financial aid and scholarships may only be applied toward tuition.

What is offered and how it is done

Amounts awarded:

Financial aid may be any amount up to \$500. Most winning applicants receive \$200 to \$250. Amount of financial aid depends on the quality of the application and the amount of aid available.

Qualifications: Must be between the ages of 13 and 18 by June 21. Criteria of both **need** and **ability** will be weighed in the decision. Keep this in mind when completing the application procedure. While we do not require financial records, we do need to know about your financial need as well as

your demonstrated ability in art. *Financial aid is solely intended to help talented students with financial need attend CSAI.*

Judging: Administration at Cranbrook Academy of Art along with Chris Schneider, program manager of CSAI, will review applications.

Deadline: There is no deadline to apply for financial aid. As long as there are classes available for registration (registration is ongoing until each class fills, at which time a waiting list is formed), financial aid applications will still be

accepted. The deadline for scholarships was April 16th and has passed.

Notification of the Results: Financial aid applicants will be notified in a timely manner, usually within one to two weeks.
